After the national webcast program, Frank Jannuzi, in person, will comment on the webcast speech and will also speak on the subject of “Six Dragons Imperiling the Rise of China, and Implications for U.S.-China Relations”. Prior to his present position with the Mansfield Foundation, Mr. Jannuzi served as Policy Director, East Asian and Pacific Affairs, for the U.S. Senate Foreign Relations Committee from 1997 to 2012. He is also a visiting lecturer at the Johns Hopkins Krieger School of Arts & Sciences.
